Babe Atkins-Byrne \$1,000.00 Scholarship

Purpose:

This scholarship was established to honor *Babe Atkins-Byrne in 2006* for her untiring work and service in CCRWC. She served as the Membership Chairman for more than 20 years. As a result of her efforts through the years, the Cobb County Club became the largest Republican Women's Club in the state of Georgia. After Babe passed away in 2020, the scholarship now remains in honor of her memory.

The scholarship is to be awarded to a female Cobb County resident who is a rising freshman, or already enrolled in a secondary education program. The scholarship is provided to assist in the undergraduate educational development of the student that is currently enrolled in a secondary education program.

Process:

The CCRWC Scholarship Committee consist of a chairman and two members.

- The Committee will meet and review the applications. It shall make a decision to award the scholarship(s) to no more than two applicants based on budget approvals by the Board.
- An interview in person, by phone or by zoom with an applicant or applicants will be scheduled by the Scholarship Committee.
- An applicant who is active duty military and/or has served in combat in the past thirty-six (36) months shall be given high consideration.
- The check is sent directly to the college or university where the applicant has been accepted or is currently enrolled. The applicant is to provide the committee a correct address for where the check is to be mailed.
- An applicant who has applied and/or received this scholarship in any previous year may apply again.

- Fill out the application completely. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Results:

All applicants are notilied of the results. All scholarship recipients are invited as a guest to the General Meeting of the Cobb County Republican Women's Club where the presentation of the scholarship is made. While the Committee prefers the winning applicant to attend, some circumstances prohibit attendance; in that case, she should make every effort to send someone to accept the presentation on her behalf.

Disbursement: Disbursement is made in the form of a check that is payable to the educational institution of choice and addressed to the financial aid officer to credit the account of the student.
